When her mother returned, she did not know her husband or her children and Virgie could not understand why she had changed. At 16, Virgie made the decision to leave Kentucky and the only life she had ever known after discovering her prostitute mother was having an affair with the young boy Virgie loved. Filled with hatred, resentment, and shame for the woman she called Mom, it was not until her mother's funeral, did she learn the horrible truth, the reason for her change and the reason why she became the town whore, a weedmonkey. A haunting true story... Special note about Weedmonkey from the author: "My mother Victoria started writing this book when I was a little girl and the recollection is from her memory of her childhood. In 2006, she was diagnosed with terminal cancer and given three months to live. On her deathbed, she asked me to finish writing it for her."

In February 1954, Victoria Edwards bled to death after a botched dental procedure. Three days later, she woke up in the morgue wearing a toe tag. She was 25. After routine dental surgery goes horribly wrong, Victoria bleeds to death and is pronounced dead and placed in the hospital morgue. While "dead" she visited "somewhere" and was placed in a learning center where she learned the answers to some of life's most controversial questions and was shown visions of the horrifying consequences of certain women's fate. Fifty two years later... On April 30, 2006... she got her wish. Where there are question marks, there are spots in the tape where her words cannot be understood. Where the tape says it has been "45 years" this refers to the time the tape was made. In actuality, it has now been 59 years (2013). No editing was done on this book to maintain the authenticity of her words, feelings and experience. It was typed exactly as the author heard it... word for word. Her name was changed per her request to protect the privacy of her family. The name used in the book was chosen by her.

Appalachian Mountain Girl is a sensitive and beautifully written autobiographical account of a childhood in the coalmine district of Depression-era Kentucky. With humor and warmth—but without sentimentality—Rhoda Warren recounts the lives of these mining people whose religion and family values buttressed and sustained them. As a young girl, Rhoda began to catch glimpses of the world outside her narrow mountain community through the stories in True Confessions magazine and the pictures in the Montgomery Ward catalog—which to her seemed like "visions of a fairy world." When Rhoda married and moved to a small town in New York State, it seemed that her dreams of a better life had been realized. Yet scenes of Letcher always "hovered in the back roads of her memory." When she revisited her homeland, this time as a New Yorker, Rhoda found that Letcher was no longer the place of her memories.

In 1874, an amazing event took place--the American Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (ASPCA) initiated the rescue of a severely abused child named Mary Ellen Wilson. Her rescue initiated the beginning of true child protection in this country, and eventually, the first child protection agency in America was formed.
